1 Update of work done

- ❖ A grant was secured from Yorventure towards new equipment in St James Close Play Park which has now been completed.
- ❖ The damaged wall in the new burial ground was repaired and a new barrier was erected at the ramp into the area.
- A bench was provided in the bus shelter.
- ❖ The damaged wall near the ford on West Road was finally repaired by NYCC after several years of waiting.
- ❖ Trees near the cottages on the village green were pruned.
- ❖ A successful Christmas Carol event was held in the Church to raise funds for the Church "Flush Fund"
- ❖ A number of volunteers came forward to participate in the Community Speed Watch scheme which is now operational and working well.
- ❖ A grasscrete surface has been provided by Richmondshire District Council for residents to park at the old canteen site. The Parish Council is providing £2000 towards the cost of installation. Residents are encouraged to use the parking area to reduce the number of vehicles parked on Moor Road.
- Richmondshire District Council are now conducting weekly inspections of the 3 play parks and an Annual Inspection was carried out by the Play Inspection Company in December, no major issues were identified.
- ❖ The Emergency Planning Committee has made good progress with a meeting in January involving a number of volunteers. Work on the plan is progressing.
- ❖ The precept for 2017/18 was increased to £9000 this is the first time it has been increased for a number of years.
- ❖ The grass cutting contract for 2017/18 was awarded to Mac Plant who will now also cut the grass and hedges in the 3 play parks as well as the village green, new burial ground and verges. The heap of soil and stones has been removed from the new burial ground and work is in hand to tidy up the area.
- The picnic bench in Moor Road Play Park has been repaired.

2 Planning

❖ The Parish Council has made comments on a number of new planning applications for proposed small works within the Parish. There is currently no further information regarding the proposed development at Limegarth.
