Update of work done

- Play parks: Documentation is signed and the handover is complete. The PC is simply awaiting paperwork from the solicitor and a copy of the playing fields lease from RDC.
- ❖ The PC hopes to purchase the zip wire for the Moor Road playing field site and picnic tables for the park. It is hoped that the play park sub committee will help get this project off the ground.
- Red telephone box adoption: The phone box is now to paint and decide what to do with it. Any suggestions? The PC would like to run a school competition.
- St James Close footpath repairs: We are still waiting for the work to be completed to make good the damage done during the repairs to the footpath last year.
- Work continues on the Emergency planning document. Thank you to the volunteers who have come forward. The review of the Neighbourhood watch contacts continues and new volunteers would be welcome.
- ❖ A meeting has occurred with RDC to discuss the Richmondshire Local Plan Core Strategy and the implications for Melsonby.
- Shovels were purchased to go with the grit bin on High Row; feedback is very positive from residents of High Row who were very pleased to have the new grit bin.
- Speed calming measures: The PC would like to have physical speed calming measures as well as a speed matrix for monitoring speeding. NRCP has possible monies available for funding a speed matrix equipment base. This is being looked into.
- ❖ The PC have made a successful bid to the NRCP for funds towards a root tree to plant on the Village Green for future use as the village Christmas tree.
- ❖ Dog fouling: A sign is to be placed on the Village Green to inform people that it is a children's playing area, in a means to combat dog fouling on the green. The PC is looking at further steps from Street Scene and the possibility of CCTV in the village.
- ❖ The PC intends to apply for the Tour de France grant which has £500 available to provide "pop up car park"s in the village. Please look out for further details on this venture.
