### 1 Parish Council Updates

- ❖ Election of the Offices of Chair Person and Vice Chair: It was agreed by the Parish Council that Angus Stokoe and Vince Elrington would continue as Chair and Vice Chair.
- ❖ **Speeding**: The Community Speed Watch monitoring is down on last year. We are investigating the possibility of installing a new permanent sign at the entrance to the village advertising the Speed Watch scheme.
- ❖ Village green: Richmondshire District Council have approved removal and sculpture of one of the sycamore trees on the village green next to Church Row. Work hopes to be carried out in June. An area of the green is to be levelled for port-a-loos on Sports Day.
- ❖ Village Green Registration: An application has been made to register the village green to protect its status. This application will be advertised in the press in due course.
- ❖ Street Light: The Parish Council are still waiting for Richmondhsire District Council to provide quotes for installing a new streetlight near the bridge at Church Row.
- ❖ Play parks: The Play Park sub-committee would like to provide football nets in Moor Road play park, this had been agreed at a previous meeting and a quote has now been obtained for new posts and nets. The Sports Day committee have donated £300 towards the cost and Melsonby Parish Council will pay the remaining amount.
- ❖ Parish Plan: Judith Stansfield has completed the review of the Parish Plan. This has been registered with Richmondshire District Council and requires to be reviewed/updated every 5 years
- ❖ General Data Protection: The Parish Council have agreed to register with the ICO. The cost to do so is £40.
- **Storage container:** The Parish Council is investigating purchasing a storage container.
- ❖ Tidy Gardens: Vince Elrington is putting together a criteria for this year's competition. Which will be judged in late July/early August.
- ❖ Best Kept Village: The village has entered into the Rotary Club of Richmond's annual "Best Kept Village" competition. Residents are encouraged to take part. More details to be advertised on the website and noticeboard.

- ❖ Wheels-2-Work Scheme: Wheels 2 Work (a not for profit charity) has a fleet of mopeds for loan. Successful candidates receive a moped, safety equipment, insurance, tax and bike servicing for a small weekly contribution. To be eligible for the scheme you must: Live in North Yorkshire; be 16 or over; have no suitable transport to travel to work, training or education; hold a provisional licence.
