1 Parish Council Updates

- Road Safety Campaign, Keep Melsonby Safe: The Visual Activated Sign (VAS), on the east side of Moor Road, has been installed, training has been given to some residents and is now active.

2 Planning

❖ A full planning application has been received for the Limegarth development site. Planning gave a short timeframe to respond to this application. The Parish Council agreed that this application is complex and needs to encompass concerns and comments from residents of Melsonby. An Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM) took place on 3rd September 2020, virtually via Zoom. All concerns were shared and noted and a detailed response was drafted in response to the application. The response took into account the concerns and comments shared with the previous developer in 2015 and addressed further concerns. The Parish Council felt that the application should be put on hold until the current village water and sewerage infrastructure is reviewed. District Council Jimmy Wilson-Petch has supported the response and has asked that a full council planning meeting takes place.
